Position Description

Reports to	This position reports to TNA’s Executive Director and is supervised by TNA’s Program Manager.
Liases with	This position works regularly with the other TNA core and contract staff as needed.
Hours	This is a part time position 0.8 EFT, 4 days a week. Standard hours are <i>within</i> Monday – Friday, 9am-6pm, with a lunch break, although actual hours worked are flexible and may be worked over multiple days.
Remuneration	\$80,000 pro-rata, per annum plus Superannuation and all entitlements.
Location	This position will primarily be based in the TNA office, however this is some flexibility for working remotely where possible.
Term	16 January 2023 to 20 December 2024

Role Overview

This role works alongside the TNA Program Manager to deliver services to the Circus and Physical Theatre (CaPT) sector, including those outlined in TNA's CaPT Strategy, and new initiatives supported by the Australia Council for the Arts commencing in 2023.

In line with TNA's 2021-2025 Strategic Plan, all TNA roles take an active part in meeting Objectives 1-5:

- First Nations First
- Justice and Diversity
- Safe Theatres
- Access and Inclusion
- Gender Equity

For this position, it means:

- ensuring that the artists, producers, and organisations we work with and service understand these justice principles
- developing, implementing, and evaluating key activities detailed in our Equity Action Plan
- that we design our work to address the gaps

Key Tasks

Circus and Physical Theatre (CaPT) Strategy

In collaboration with the TNA Program Manager:

- Assist with reviewing and implementing TNA's CaPT strategy, in order to increase the visibility and health of the CaPT sector,
- Co-ordinate the CaPT advisory committee and take minutes for the meetings,
- Research, write and distribute the quarterly CaPT sector bulletin,
- Maintain the CaPT database and resources on the TNA website.

First Nations Circle

In collaboration with the TNA Program Manager:

- Provide support to an emerging First Nations producer who is working on this program.
- Assist with convening meetings of the FN Circle and providing administrative support for circle members.



- Assist with creating and sharing any outcomes such as the action plan and best practice guide.

Circus Rigging Initiative

In collaboration with the TNA Program Manager:

- Coordinate the selection and administration process to provide 30 rigging tickets for circus riggers.
- Run the EOI process for two scholarships in the Certificate III in Rigging and support the successful candidates.
- Establish an Australian circus riggers network
- Set up a circus riggers database hosted on the TNA website.
- Work towards the development of a national standard for circus rigging and safety.
- Advocate for and work with the sector towards the establishment of a circus-specific training course.

Marketing, Evaluation and Documentation

- Promote and communicate the program elements and timelines to the sector.
- Ensure program activities are appropriately documented and disseminated – e.g. still images, video, written documentation, data collection, testimonials.
- Undertake surveys at the close of the programs and evaluate findings.

Administration/Other

- Support other TNA staff with other TNA programs where time allows.
- Attend and participate in staff meetings and other meetings as required.

Selection Criteria

1. Professional producing experience (including management and administration) in the Circus and Physical Theatre sector.
2. Experience curating, organising, delivering, and evaluating events.
3. Strong communication skills and writing skills – experience speaking at events and meetings.
4. A deep understanding of the need for the performing arts sector to be safe and inclusive for people from under-represented groups such as First Nations people, people of colour, Deaf/Disabled people, people from regional areas, and the LGBTIQ+ community.
