

## Dogging

Dogging is a prerequisite for a rigging ticket, making it a critical High Risk Work License (HRWL) to legally rig in the CaPT sector. Courses are generally 5 consecutive days but can be up to 8 days long. Skills learnt include how to direct a crane, how to sling loads and calculate the sling capacity ready for lifting.

Please note: every HRW License completed requires a **Victorian postal address** and an **additional fee of \$66.60** for issuing your license.
