

Elevated Working Platform (EWP)

EWP operation is a common part of rigging in the CaPT sector, there are several different courses available:

- EWP under 11m
- EWP Over 11m
- Boom type EWP, boom length 11m or more

Boom type EWP, boom length 11m or more is the only course that is a High-Risk Work License (HRWL) and allows you to operate the many different types of EWP's, this is the most comprehensive course.

Please note: every HRWL completed requires a **Victorian postal address** and an **additional fee of around \$70** for issuing your license.

CFMEU

Dates: 4-day course split over 2 weeks, availability currently available from March 2024, CFMEU only advertises one or two courses in advance, once those courses fill up, they will advertise the next dates.

Cost: \$0

Entry requirements: White card, 18 years of age, PPE hard hat, safety boots and hi vis clothing.

Foresite training

Foresite training is approved for skills first funding but are currently preparing to start the program and cannot give specific information. Check back end of Jan.
