Rigging – Intermediate

A Rigging Intermediate High Risk Work License (HRWL) enables a person to legally rig more complicated equipment. Mostly the course is about constructing cranes, within the CAPT sector common requirements are the ability to control more than one chain motor at a time.

Please note every HRWL completed requires a **Victorian postal address** and an **additional fee of \$66.60** for issuing your license.

Entry Requirements: PPE, Hard hat, Safety Footwear and Hi vis clothing, White card, Working safely at heights, EWP over 11m and Basic Rigging license.
